Ann Taylor McLeod, 65, of Tallahassee, FL, passed away suddenly on March 20, 2024.

Ann was born on January 8, 1959 to John and Virginia Taylor. She was the youngest of four children: the late John Taylor, Jr; the late Edith Gay Taylor, and Patricia Lott. Ann treasured her family and spoke of them often.

Ann graduated from Southland Academy in Americus, GA. Hoping to follow in her father's footsteps of being a pharmacist, Ann attended the University of Georgia School of Pharmacy and graduated with her bachelor's degree.
