Benjamin R. Buda, Jr., completed his journey home to be with the Lord on February 8, 2025. He passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones at the age of 81. Born on December 28, 1943, in Santa Ana, California, he lived a life devoted to faith, family, and service. The son of a Marine, he spent his youth in New York, moving with family to Jacksonville Beach following the death of his father. Shortly after moving to Florida, he met the love of his life, Barbara, and their relationship grew into a lifelong love story and 60 years of marriage.

He dedicated six years of his life to serving in the National Guard in Jacksonville. His professional career included roles in sales and management and as an insurance agent. His true passion was his commitment to faith. At San Jose Catholic Church, he was the music minister for Sunday masses and he and Barbara taught Sunday school. His dedication continued at Assumption Catholic Church, where he served as a group leader for the charismatic prayer group. At Good Shepherd Catholic Church, he taught Confirmation classes and was a member of Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) men's group and the Life Teen group music ministry. His love for God was matched only by his love for family.

He is survived by his beloved bride, Barbara; three sons, Rob (Stacie) Buda, Rick Buda, and Chris (Amy) Buda; two daughters, Karen (Chip) Collier, and

Emily (Tom) Kanoza. He is also survived by his three sisters, Bernadette Rowe, Carolyn (Raymond) Pierce, and Cathy (Pete) Wilson, along with eight grandchildren, many nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was predeceased by his father, Benjamin R. Buda; Mother, Alice (Buda) Staszak; step-father, Ray Staszak; grandson, Bryce Buda; daughter-in-law, Jill Buda; and brother-in-law, Michael Rowe.

A Memorial Mass will be held on February 28, 2025, at 1:00 PM at Good Shepherd Catholic Church in Tallahassee (4665 Thomasville Road), with a reception immediately following the service. The mass will also be available by livestream at goodshepherdparish.org.

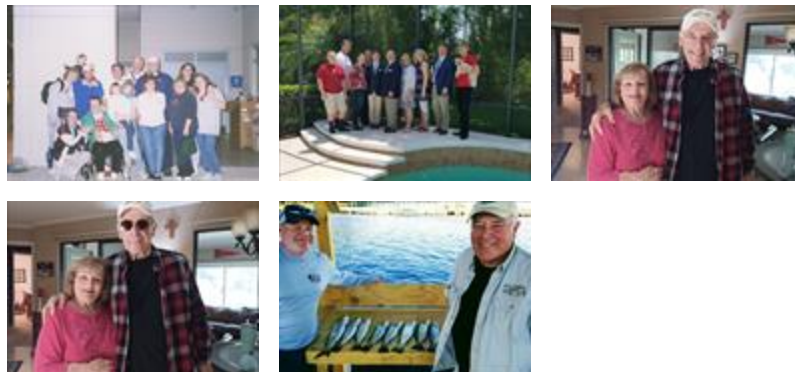
