November 17, 1935 - August 15, 2023

Boyd David Charles passed peacefully surrounded by loved ones at the age of 87 on August 15, 2023 at his home in Tallahassee, Florida. He was born to the loving family of James Robert Charles and Mae Quarles Charles in rural mountains of Etowah, Tennessee on November 17, 1935 and was the fifth of eleven children. He later moved to and grew up on a dairy farm in Sumter, South Carolina.

He graduated from Cross High School in Cross, South Carolina, then received his Bachelor's Degree from Erskine College in Due West, South Carolina and returned to school in adulthood to earn his Masters Degree in Counseling Education from Radford University in Virginia. He served in the Army Reserves for 6 years and had an honorary discharge. He had a long career in the banking and loan business in San Diego, CA, Jacksonville, FL, New Orleans, LA, and Sumter, SC. After graduating with his Masters Degree he worked in the counseling field in Roanoke, VA, Summerville, SC and Baton Rouge, LA. After retirement he worked at H & R Block as a tax preparer for 15 years.

Boyd is known for his bright blue eyes, friendly smile and going out of his way for family and friends alike. He had a deep love of the outdoors with his favorite pastimes being gardening, fishing and reading. Those were second only to his adoration of his wife Yolande and his passion for supporting family.

After raising 3 daughters, he stepped up and adopted two sons later in life and raised them as his own. He taught all his children the importance of family, and the values of hard work, honesty, and faith in God. From his fascination with words, he had a vast vocabulary and his love for music often meant him singing along with the classical country melodies. And he never met an apple pie a la mode he wasn't prepared to enjoy.

He and his wife, Yolande, of 40 years shared many past times including country western dancing, saltwater fishing, spending time with family and serving their faith community. Boyd touched many lives in his service to the Lions Club, and in his service with Yolande in Marriage Encounter and Marriage Prep for engaged couples, as well as a Reader, Eucharistic Minister and co-leader of the Small Christian Community group for St. Jude Catholic Church in Baton Rouge. In Tallahassee he served Blessed Sacrament Church in his participation in the Mens CHURP Group, which he loved dearly. He spent the last year and a half with family residing in Tallahassee, FL.

He is survived by his wife Yolande St. Pierre Charles, his children Cindy Lefleur (Mark), Cheryl Lewis (Jeff), Dennis St. Pierre Charles (Elizabeth), and Michael Charles, grandchildren Crystal Waddell (JB), Brittany Fleming, Brandon Dupont, Isabella, Serafina, Rachel and Maya and great grandchildren Kaitlyn, Sadie and Maggie, Haiden, Amy Lee and Luke and siblings Mildred Avin, Bob Charles, Tom Charles and Mary Jane McLeod.
