Fred Anthony Addonizio, Jr. passed away Sunday, April 18, 2021 at Capital Regional Medical Center after a brief illness. He was 77.

Fred was born on July 25, 1943 in Mt. Vernon, New York, to Fred Addonizio Sr. and Josephine Santorelli, first-generation immigrants from Campania, Italy.
