James Lauren Folsom, Jr., a dedicated public servant and beloved family man, passed away peacefully on September 3, 2024 at the age of 57. Born on July 7, 1967 in Marianna Florida, “Larry” (as he preferred to be called) grew up in Tallahassee, Florida and chose to serve his country at a young age, enlisting in the United States Navy at 17.

Following his honorable discharge, Larry continued his commitment to service by joining the Leon County Sheriff's Office on July 11, 1988. Over the next 30 years, he dedicated himself to protecting and serving his community, working in a variety of roles within the department. His colleagues remember him for his unwavering professionalism, his strong work ethic, and his compassionate heart. While pursuing his career in law enforcement, Larry also was very involved in various martial arts communities. He earned a black belt in both Judo and Brazilian Jiu Jitsu, and enjoyed being a referee at MMA fights. In addition, Larry was an active volunteer with St. Francis Wildlife and considered it to be his duty to cut fishing wire, stop for turtles, and pick up trash while he was exploring outdoors. He would regularly remind people to keep turtles moving in the same direction that they had been traveling and not to turn them around.

Outside of his professional life and hobbies, Larry was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He is survived by his loving wife of 26 years, Maria,

his two children, Rebecca Folsom McCoy and Wesley Folsom, and his two cherished grandchildren, Debra and Malcolm McCoy. He is also survived by his mother, Ruth Smith, and his two sisters Theresa Folsom and Cinnamon Walker. He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

A memorial service will be held on October 19, 2024 from 4-6 PM at Northside Community Center which is located at 8005 Oak Grove Rd, Tallahassee, Florida 32312. In lieu of flowers, the family requests that donations be made to St. Francis Wildlife in Larry Folsom's memory.
