Kenneth Arnold Mitchell, 76, of Tallahassee, Florida went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 8, 2020.

Ken was a very proud Veteran of the United State's Army, spending a 4 year tour in Vietnam. To Ken, it was an honor to serve the United State's in such an important way. He risked his life, to protect those of us he didn't even know.

Ken is the beloved husband of Reyna Mitchell. After giving her a roll of quarters, a carton of cigarettes, and a dozen black roses (an inside joke between the two of them), Reyna agreed to go out on a date with Kenand that is where their life together began. On June 16, 1977 at 4:00 AM, in a little chapel in Las Vegas, Nevada, Ken married Reyna. Together, they settled in Tallahassee, Florida in a small trailer off of highway 20. Ken drove a cab for about 5 years before opening his own business as a handy-man. A true "Jack of all Trades," Ken ran his business for some 25 years before retiring. Reyna was the love of Ken's life, and they were happily married for 43 years.

In his retirement years, Ken enjoyed all of the time he got to spend with his family and friends. Ken was a true fisherman and enjoyed fishing on the days he caught a mess of fish, and even on the days he didn't. Ken loved life and had fun doing a variety of things. His hobbies included everything from building boats, canning vegetables, reading, drawing, watching old war movies and NASCAR races, to making wine. One of his favorite things to do every year was prepare Thanksgiving dinner for his family.

Ken was the loving father to Kenneth Mitchell, Jr. (Deanna Mitchell), Chylene Mitchell (Viola Fay Mitchell), Helen Mitchell (David Ehrlich), and Cristina White (David White). He was the proud grandfather to Kamren, Chylene Mitchell, Jr., Samuel Mitchell, Alexandra Mitchell, Natalia Mitchell, Dalila Ehrlich, Michael Moore, Maria White, and Gracey White. He was also the loving brother to Doug Mitchell and Fran Baranofski.

With all of the things Ken enjoyed doing, one of his favorite things was to spend time with his grandkids who he loved very much. You could routinely find him sipping on his cold, black coffee while making waffles and pancakes for them.

Kenneth Mitchell left this world surrounded by the love of his family and the

support of his friends. He will be missed by many - but each of them will carry on with the fond memories of the good times they shared with Ken.
