Kevin Dale Moore, 57, passed away on February 28, 2024.

A son of the late Spencer Dale Moore and Anna Frances Belcher Moore, Kevin was born in Tallahassee, FL on February 12, 1967.

From a young age, Kevin possessed a natural curiosity about the world around him. As a child, he enjoyed taking toys apart and helping his dad put them back together. He had a deep desire to learn and explore! At nine years old, Kevin accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior and was baptized on September 10, 1975, which undoubtedly played a significant role throughout his life.

Kevin's teenage years were marked by a passion for classical piano. He also found fulfillment in cooking and sharing his creations with those around him throughout his life. He also had a gift for knowing how to fix things and worked as a mechanic.

Kevin began his military career in 1984 when he joined the Florida Army National Guard, serving for a period of 2 years. Following his service in the National Guard, he continued his military journey by enlisting in the United States Army, where he served for 7 years.

Kevin's military journey took him from his hometown of Tallahassee, Florida to Colorado in 1988 due to military assignments. During the Desert Storm, he served a hardship tour in Sinop, Turkey as a member of the U.S. Army Signal Corps. Following this assignment, he concluded his military service in Albuquerque, New Mexico. His commendable service during White Sands Missile Range earned him the prestigious Joint Commission Award, reflecting his dedication and proficiency in his duties.

Following a service injury and honorable discharge from the military, Kevin encountered challenges with pain management and often sought comfort in ways that weren't conducive to his well-being. After a period of struggle, he discovered a Christian rehabilitation center in Titusville, FL. Drawing strength from his faith, Kevin embarked on a journey of sobriety. He also became a beacon of hope for many young men battling their own addictions, through his involvement and leadership in the ministry at Liberty Lodge.

Kevin's struggle with addiction was indeed a relentless battle, marked by both victories and setbacks. Despite the times when the grip of addiction seemed insurmountable, there were also extended periods of sobriety when Kevin's strength and resilience shone through, illuminating the lives of those around him with the light of his faith in Jesus Christ.

Kevin is survived by his mother; two daughters: Amanda Guthrie Griffin, and Sabrina Gabreille Moore; his son: Joshua Dale Guthrie (Lacy); his grandchildren: Logan Gabriel Griffin, Lillian Sybil Griffin, Kylie Skye Guthrie, and Braelyn Drew Guthrie; his brothers: Darrell Brian Moore (Donna), his sister Bonnie Moore Helgemo (Brian); and Jonathan Andrew Moore (Rebecca); as well as many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his Father, his brother Rodney Allen Moore, and his son-in-law Stephen Griffin (Amanda).

A memorial service will be held at Tallahassee National Cemetery on Friday March 29, 2024, at 2:00 PM.
