In loving memory of Norman Ray San Soucie age 94 of Tallahassee, Florida, who passed away May 25, 2023. He was born December 22, 1928 in York, Pennsylvania to the late Victor and Jean (Kennedy) San Soucie.

Norm served proudly in the U.S. Army during both World War II (as an enlisted soldier in Occupied Japan) and the Korean War (as a commissioned officer). He attained the rank of Captain while serving his country. Between his two stints in the Army, Norm attended both York Junior College and Gettysburg College where he graduated with a degree in Business. He was a member of the Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity.

Norm married his wife of 72 years, Mary Lou (Spangler) on June 10, 1950. After working for the Bendix Corporation in York, Pennsylvania, Norm was hired by the Burroughs Corporation in 1959 where he worked in manufacturing management until he was hired as a vice president of manufacturing by the communications company Infotron in 1982. His work took him and his family to Paoli, PA, Honey Brook PA, Downingtown PA, and eventually Marlton, NJ.

Norm retired in June 1991, at which time, he and Mary Lou moved back to their hometown of York.

Norm was deeply involved with the service club Sertoma, where he served in

various positions and was very involved in the community service the club provided. Norm and Mary Lou enjoyed many years of traveling and visiting family and friends after retirement.

In August of 2017 Norm and Mary Lou relocated to Tallahassee, Florida, although his heart remained with his hometown of York. Norm was a very devoted and loving husband, father and grandfather. He was a man of integrity, you could count on him to do the right thing, tell the truth, give good advice, work hard and be a good mentor to family and countless friends. He enjoyed fishing, boating, owning cars, old and new, refinishing furniture and spending time with family and friends. He could fix anything, do almost any job around the house and was a wealth of information and help to many through the years.

Norman is survived by his wife Mary Lou (Spangler); his children Denise (Robert), David (Lori), Michael (Lynn) and his grandchildren Philip (Janice), Stephen (Kei), Lila (Jason) and Ethan as well as great grandchildren Oscar and Juniper. Norman was predeceased by his infant son Philip Norman.
