“ Rachel Campbell was an incredibly unique, intelligent, and powerful woman. It was an honor to know her and call her my friend. She held a fierce love for her daughters and actively chose to always place their needs above her own, all the way up to her own death.

Rachel suffered endlessly from physical impairments that ravaged her body since childhood. The last three to five years of her life were, without question, the most difficult and debilitating for her after she was misdiagnosed during a hospitalization, subsequently requiring immediate dialysis treatment. Despite her ever increasing limitations physically, Rachel looked forward to her time with Scarlett during the week, then every other week when she's started school.

Rachel was always sharing with me her excitement over plans she had made or ideas she had for her and Scarlett each and every Thursday evening prior to a Friday pick-up. There were two favorite pastimes that they both seemed to get a thrill out of, the first being Sunday brunch at our local Cafe where Rachel would regale me with stories of Scarlett consistently ordering a cinnamon roll that was the size of her head! Rachel also truly enjoyed spending time with Scarlett and having their her nails done. She would often let Scarlett pick out the polish, but Rachel really beamed with pride when they would come home with matching nail colors. Rachel was so honored Scarlett wanted to look like her mom on those days - it meant so much to both of them and it was obvious on their faces!

Since Scarlett was removed from her home under proven false pretenses in 2020 until Rachel passed, not a day went by without her doing something, taking an action, or speaking with an attorney in an effort to regain custody of Scarlett and clear her name. Furthermore, she wanted to ensure that in the meantime, in her absence, Scarlett remained fully aware of how much Rachel loved, wanted, and was fighting for her. Rachel followed every protocol to have access to Scarlett once again and I hope that the undying love of this mother for her child is repeatedly enforced to this sweet

*young girl who is now without a mom forever. The stress of the continued false allegations against Rachel were unfair, unjust, cruel, caused substantial stress resulting in a considerable downturn in her health, and have served to taint the memory of a truly remarkable woman who deserved more kindness and support than she received in life, as well as far more reverence than has been shown in her passing.*

*I pray each and every day for the wellbeing of Scarlett. I pray that she is cared for in a home that is well-kept and focused on her success in and out of the classroom. I pray for her to hear how much her mother loved her and for her to have the opportunity to have positive conversations about Rachel whenever she wishes. I pray Scarlett is able to feel the embrace of her mother's love every night before she goes to sleep, each morning when it is time to get ready for the day, and prior to every momentous occasion in her life. In sum, I pray that Scarlett is raised in the same way Rachel would have raised her, empowering her, ensuring she felt beautiful inside and out, intellectually stimulating her, and keeping that giggle and smile going for eternity!*
