



## Steven McGlamory

April 1, 1961 - July 20, 2024

Steven Mark McGlamory (“Stevie Mac”), 63, of Monticello, Florida, passed away at home on July 20, 2024, with his loving family by his side. He was born to Hyman and Barbara McGlamory in Tallahassee, Florida on April 1, 1961.

Stevie was a second generation Autobody Technician and carried on his father’s legacy in the industry. In 2016 Stevie opened his home-based business S’Macs Collision and Restoration Services, LLC in Monticello, Florida, servicing Jefferson, Madison, and Leon Counties. He did bodywork his entire life and loved what he did.

Stevie never met a stranger and loved making deals with people on just about anything. He loved his family dearly and being a grandfather was what made his life complete. He enjoyed riding his Harley with his wife Ana. In 2017 he took his motorcycle for a ride on the notorious Tail of the Dragon in Tennessee, experiencing 318 curves in 11 miles (one of his bucket list items).

Stevie was pretty much a homebody, but he and Ana were able to check something else off of his bucket list last year when they rode Amtrak’s California Zephyr Rail Experience from Chicago, IL to San Francisco, California, taking in the beauty you can only see by train, across the Rocky Mountains, through Utah, and into California.

Stevie is survived by his wife of 33 years, Ana Obrero McGlamory, his three daughters CJ Lewis (Robert), Dakota Traxler (Wilson), and Brooklyn Harrell (Austin); two grandsons, Gabriel Lewis and Michael Lewis (Emma); three granddaughters, Gracie Lewis, Charlee Mac Harrell and Anabelle Traxler; and brother Scott McGlamory (Balinda). He was preceded in death by his parents Hyman Alan McGlamory and Barbara Hampton McGlamory; brother Ronald Alan McGlamory; and sister Debra Ann McGlamory.
