



## Timothy E. Gosline-Bromm

October 31, 1982 - August 26, 2024

Timothy Emerson Gosline-Bromm, 41, passed away in his home in Tallahassee on August 26th, 2024. He was born October 31, 1982 in St Augustine, Florida.

Timothy is survived by his mother Molly Gosline, his dear friend Alfred Morris, his Aunt and Uncle Anne and Mark Barnes, many cousins, his longtime girlfriend Rebecca Lynn as well as several members of the Bromm family. He was ranked 17th by the State of Florida in High School Chess and graduated Summa Cum Laude at Florida State University with bachelor's degrees in both International Affairs and History. He went on to spend several years traveling in China and South Korea, teaching English at primary, secondary and university levels (TESOL). While overseas, he studied Mandarin Chinese, Mahayana Buddhism and China's dynastic history.

After returning to the states, he completed certifications including Exceptional Student Education (ESE) and continued teaching at middle and high school levels for both History and Chess. His most recent career path led him to the Liberty County Department of Corrections as a GED and ESL (English as a Second Language) instructor.

Timothy also volunteered along side of his mother as an advocate for people with disabilities, traveling to Washington DC and all over the state of Florida.

Timothy remained incredibly skilled and active in Chess, Disc Golf, and Billiards, though he was most passionate about helping to spread knowledge of native gardening to foster wildlife corridors through residential spaces. He had his own home certified as a wildlife sanctuary, finalized with an FSU Seminole mailbox.

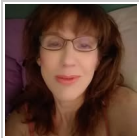
